STUDY CIRCLES – INFO SHEET

What are study circles?

In addition to organising events, the Academy acts as a platform for main topics such as consciousness and community, economy, relationship, education etc. The study circles are created by the initiative of individual people who wish to look into a specific subject on a deeper level. The members of a study circle organise themselves independently.

What are the functions and aims of a study circle?

Essentially, the aim is to gain more awareness for a certain main topic. Then, events, concrete projects in the world, publications etc. can emerge from the work of the respective circle.

It is also important to us to network with other organisations, institutions, academies and universities.

We are concerned with the following questions:

- What's at the pulse of time right now?
- What's happening in the world regarding this topic?
- What are my personal experiences? How can I exchange them?
- What can we contribute to the world regarding this topic?

It is fundamental to us that concrete projects result from the circles in order to carry the knowledge and experiences into the world instead of keeping it in the circles.

How does the Academy support the study circles?

The study circles are formed and organised by the members of the respective circle. The Academy can support the circles with the realization of events. Results from the study circles can be published on the website of the Academy after consultation.

What are the criteria for a new study circle?

Basically, the following criteria apply:

- The topic must be consistent with the aims of the Academy of Inner Science.
- The management of the Academy and the members of the circle agree on the main topics of the study circle.
- A contact person for the circle has to be named. This person is in contact with the management of the Academy.
- The participants of the circle meet regularly



How can I join a study circle?

In principle, everyone who wants to contribute actively can join a study circle. It can, however, happen that a study circle is closed due to organisational reasons, especially when too many people want to join the circle. This decision is made by the active members of the circle.

If you want to join an existing circle, please contact the Academy. Your request will be forwarded to the contact person of the respective circle.

Who bears the costs?

The members of a study circle bear any costs arising (for example travel expenses, costs for accommodation, the rent for seminar rooms, infrastructure and equipment).

The members themselves are responsible for the budgeting of events or projects. In individual cases, the Academy of Inner Science can support them in the areas of coaching, realization and budgeting.

How does Thomas Hübl support the study circles?

We imagine that Thomas brings impulses into the circles. This means for example that he participates in a meeting or an event of the circle or plays a part in another way – as it is suitable for him. His personal participation is limited because of his full schedule. However, especially in the beginning of a circle, he wants to contribute and give impulses.
